If you plan to use the computer remotely, please use commercial solutions like TeamViewer. The license manager is not compatible with Windows Shared Desktop.

Instructions

First, open the following link in your browser:


Download the installer for your operating system and install it on your PC.

The first time you launch Skydel, you will need to activate the temporary license.


Please follow these instructions:



1. Launch Skydel SDX. You should see the following message on the splash screen:




2. Click the Activate button. Skydel will open the following window:



Skydel will automatically fetch information on your computer. This information will be used to generate a license to use Skydel that will work only on this computer.



- 3. Click the Save to file button, locate the generated file (*.info) on the computer.
- 4. Fill out this form: <u>Skydel License Request form</u> then send your (*info) file to Orolia by email at the following email address: SimulationPreSalesSupport@orolia.com. Be sure to specify that you want a trial license. The Skydel support team will send you back a license file with a .lic extension.
- 5. Save the .lic file on your computer and restart Skydel.
- 6. Follow steps 2 and 3 above, but this time, instead of saving information to file, choose the license file (.lic). You may click on the "..." button to locate the .lic file.



- 7. Click Apply license with selected file button.
- 8. Restart Skydel.
